
RECKLESS DRIVING IN VIRGINIA

Most reckless driving laws in Virginia require that it be proven that the driver engaged in reckless
driving behavior. This is proven by the fact that that the driver ignores standard driving
procedures in Virginia and thereby either intentionally causing accidents or other damage to life
limb or property.

The mere endangerment of life, limb or property may result in your conviction of reckless driving in Virginia. There are many different types of reckless driving. Traveling at an excessive rate of speed alone is not the only way to be charged with reckless driving.

For example, the mere act of spinning your tires before you enter the main road may result in you being charged with reckless driving.

Reckless driving is strictly enforced by law enforcement and the Courts.
